LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD



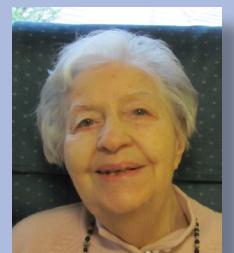
