Meet new resident **Guenter Arndt**! Guenter was born in Berlin, Germany in 1927. At age 18 he was drafted into the German army and during World War II, he was taken prisoner by the Russian army. Shrapnel got into his left lung, causing him to be classified as a “cripple” and as a result, he was spared the trip to Siberia. Instead he went home to Germany to be operated on

and get better. In his very optimistic style, Guenter shares, “It was my luck that I got wounded. It saved my life. Most people who go to Siberia do not come back.” Gifted with strong technical skills, Guenter landed at Massachusetts Institute of Technology. He was introduced to an MIT professor and in turn was hired because of his skills as a mechanic. Guenter worked at MIT for over 15 years on many different projects. “I like to do anything that’s available,” he says. “I am a technician. I am not stuck on one thing. I am interested in anything that’s educational or helpful to others.” Guenter has quickly assimilated into life at Standish. His desire for “work” has led to the creation of our first resident-run summer garden at Standish. When you are looking for Guenter, please check there! Guenter considers himself lucky in many ways, saying, “I have always had good connections. I did not look for them, they looked for me. How much better can it get?” Welcome, Guenter!
