## ASSOCIATE PROFILE

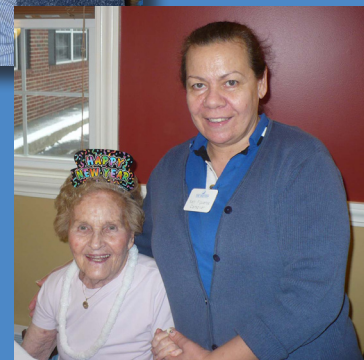
