Residents enjoy delicious healthy meals restaurant-style that feature recipes from our innovative Memory Preservation Nutrition® Program.

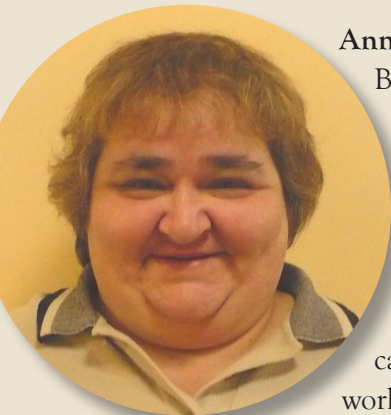
The Country Kitchen sports a diner décor with fun retro appliances.
