Franklyn’s interests have included photography, wood carving, playing cornet with the American Legion Post Band in Milton, gardening, sailing, flea marketing, and restoring antique cars, including his 1930 Model A Ford roadster. 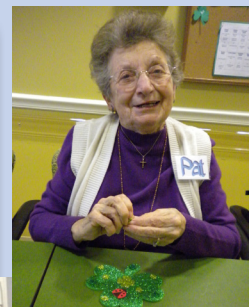
