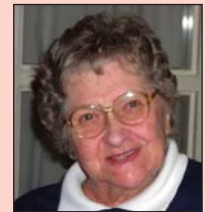

Congratulations, Emma!



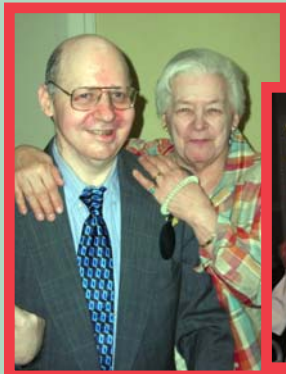
