ASSOCIATE PROFILE

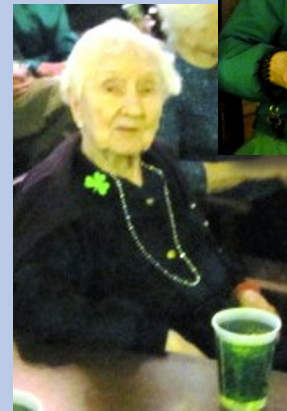

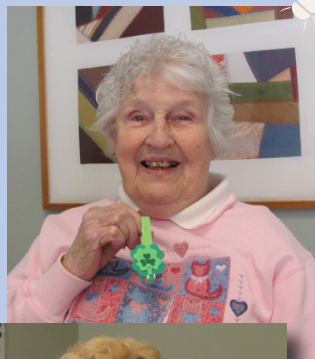
ST. PATRICK'S DAY PARTY
