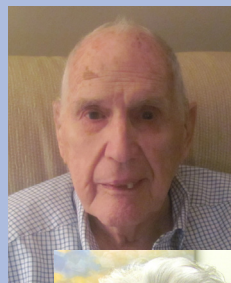
RESIDENT PROFILE

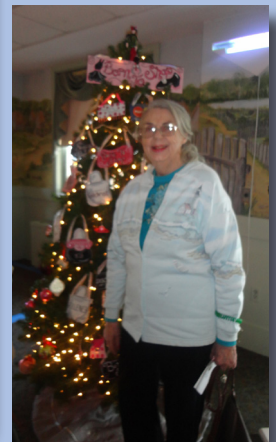
