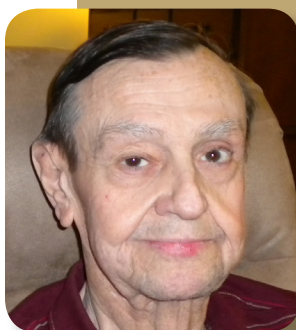

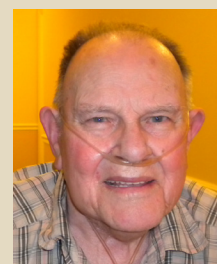
RESIDENT PROFILE
