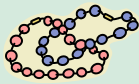

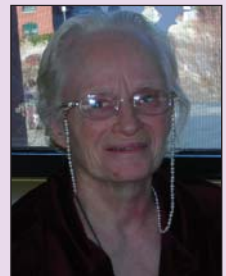


tries to attend Mass as often as she can. Welcome to Standish Village, Millie!
