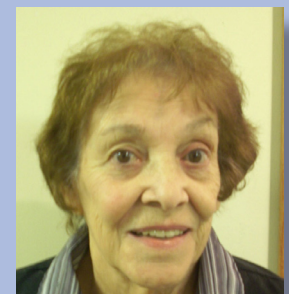
Marilyn enjoyed camping, cooking and cake decorating.
