COVERAGE FACTS

For the duration of the Covid state of emergency, Blue Cross Blue Shield will waive all member cost share for medically necessary Covid-19 testing, counseling, vaccines (when available), and treatment and supportive care at in-person doctor's offices, urgent care centers and emergency departments (excluding inpatient care) in accordance with CDC and DPH guidelines.

MENTAL & EMOTIONAL HEALTH DURING COVID-19

Emotional reactions to stressful situations such as new viruses and national emergencies are expected. Feeling sad, worried, overwhelmed, or having trouble sleeping or other symptoms of distress is normal, and there are resources available to you/your child.

- Your BCBS coverage through work covers mental health, behavioral health and substance abuse services, and you can get mental health treatment over the phone, via live video, or through other telehealth platforms

PHARMACY/MEDICATIONS

BCBS is allowing early prescription refills by lifting limits on refills of prescription medication, allowing members to obtain one additional fill of the existing prescription. They will ensure formulary flexibility if there are shortages or access issues. Members being told Blue Cross is not allowing early refills can call member service while at the pharmacy for help.
